LG OVERVIEW

DANIEL AND THE LIONS

WORSHIP LEADER: "Hello, hello, friends. I can't wait to sing with you. But first, tell me: **Who's got it?**"

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: "God's got it."

WORSHIP LEADER: "Yes! **God's got it.** Let's sing about our Great God who is Big and he loves us!"

(Lead children in singing "God is Big and He Loves Me" and "I Like To".)

"Wonderful singing, my friends. Tell me: **Who's got it?**"

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: "God's got it."

BIBLE VERSE: "Yes indeed, **God's got it.** Who can help me remember what we do next? We sang our songs. What do we do now? *(Pause.)* Yes! We say our memory verse. Are you ready to say it with me? 'He is the great God, the mighty and awesome God, Deuteronomy 10:17'. Yes!

HOST: "Our Bible story is SO awesome! And remember, if it's in the Bible *(hold up Bible)*, it is completely true. This Bible story is about a guy named Daniel. Daniel loved God and did all that He said. Every day, Daniel prayed, thanking God for the day. But there was a king named Darius whose friends told him to make a new rule. The new rule said that if anyone prayed to anyone other than the king, then they'd be thrown into a den . . . of hungry lions. YIKES! Oh no...what is Daniel going to do? *(Pause)* Let's watch our video lesson and find out. I better go grab a seat so I don't miss a minute of our Bible lesson!"

Watch Video Lesson

HOST: "Wow! God sent an angel who closed the mouths of all the lions! Daniel was safe! See, God's got it. He protected Daniel all night long. Daniel trusted in God and God protected him. And we can trust God too. He loves us, He protects us, and we don't have to worry, because **God's got it. Who's got it? God's got it.**"

WORSHIP LEADER: "Let's sing one more song about our awesome God who does great things for us."

(Lead children in singing "God Does Great Things.")

"So great! Remind me one more time: **Who's got it?**"

CHILDREN and WORSHIP LEADER: "God's got it."

WORSHIP LEADER: "That's right! And don't you forget it! See you next week!"
