BIG things

SUPPLIES: Big things page, Dot markers

What You DO and SAY:

⇒ **Pass out Big things page and Dot markers**

- *“This week we have been learning all about how God helps us do BIG things. Who helps you do big things? God helps me do big things!*
- *Can you find the word BIG on your page? That’s right! It’s the biggest word on the page!*
- *We are going to use our dot markers to decorate! Can you dot inside the letters B-I-G?*

⇒ **Complete the craft and Bring it Back to Jesus.**

- *Your signs look beautiful! Nice work!*
- *Who helps you do big things? God helps me do big things!*

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ACTIVITY

Aaron and Hur Limbo

SUPPLIES: Pool noodle, CD player, worship music

What You DO and SAY:

- ⇒ **Have children line up in the middle of the room. Leaders will hold the pool noodle up on either end.**
 - *“In our Bible story today, we learned about how Aaron and Hur helped Moses to hold up his staff so they could win the battle!*
 - *Today we are going to imagine that I have Moses’ staff right here and we are going to play a fun game! We are going to hold this noodle and you will walk under it one by one. When you walk under the noodle, walk around me and go to the back of the line. After everybody has had a turn, we will lower it and go again.*

- ⇒ **Play worship music and have kids walk under the noodle.**
 - *“Here we go! Wow! Look at you go! All right! Time to take it a little lower.*
 - *(Bring the noodle lower and lower.)*

- ⇒ **Continue as long as interest holds and then have children take a seat and Bring it Back to Jesus**
 - *“That was a fun game, but the lower it went, the harder it got! My arms got tired holding the noodle too. It’s hard to hold something in the air for that long. We heard/are going to hear a story about a man who had to hold his arms in the air for a really long time. I wonder if he needed help. Do you remember what happened? (Pause.)*
 - *Yes, Moses had to hold his staff in the air for a really long time and his arms got tired too. But what happened when he got tired? Aaron and Hur helped him! Moses’ friends were there and willing to help him.*
 - *I am so glad that God helps us do big things and they he helps us to be helpers too!*
 - *Who helps you do big things? God helps me do big things!*

- **“Today we learned about how God helped Moses do big things by giving his friends the strength to help him! We are going to make a list of people we can help. When we pray, we can ask God to help us help them. When I say your name, tell me one person you can help, and I will write it down.”**

PRAY

“Dear God, thank You for each child who is here today. I have the best job getting to help them know You better. Thank You for helping me do that each week. Today we want to ask you to help [child’s name] help [person’s name] and . . . (repeat for each child). We want to help other people do big things. We love You, God! In Jesus’ name, amen.”
