Fun “Get to Know You” Questions:

1. What is your highlight/most fun thing you’ve done this week?
2. What is the weirdest thing you’ve ever eaten?
3. What would be your dream vacation/job?
4. If you had 3 wishes, what would you wish for?
5. If you could be in any movie, and be any character, what would you choose? Why?
6. If you could eat only one thing for the rest of your life, what would it be?
7. What is your Star Wars name? **(Steps below)**
 - a. FIRST NAME
 - i. First 3 letters of last name (Example: Sar)
 - ii. Add first 2 letters of first name (Example: Gr)
 1. Your First Name would be: Sargr
 - b. LAST NAME
 - i. Last 2 letters of your last name (Example: Et)
 - ii. First 3 letters of where you were born (Example: Lon)
 1. Your Last Name would be: Etlon
 - c. RESULT: “Hello, my name is Sargr Etlon, and I am a Jedi!”

NOTE: Have kids raise their hands to speak, and then call on them. They can unmute, if muted, and they can share their answers to the above questions. Remember to stay positive and encouraging to your group. Just be positive, affirm their answers, and thank them for sharing.

Optional Activity: Rock, Paper, Scissors

If you are leading the group, students are playing against you. Give every student in the call 3-5 lives, and the only rule is do it rock-paper-scissor-shoot. Everyone in the group will be playing against just you. If your play beats theirs they lose a life, have them keep track of this in the chat. Play until the last person is standing.

What You Say:

“Great job playing everyone! At times, it was probably really frustrating if you didn’t win each round, but you chose to show determination and not give up! Way to go!”

Pray and Dismiss

- **Take prayer requests from your group about areas they need God to help them show determination.**
- **Challenge** them to be specific in their prayer requests.
 - For example, if they struggle practicing the piano because they don’t like the piano, ask God to help you to keep going, practice regularly, and finish.
 - If you struggle to be nice to a kid you don’t get along with, ask God to help you show kindness and patience when interacting with that kid.
- **Close** in prayer.

What You Say:

“God, just like we learned this week that You helped Peter and John to keep going, even when things got tough, You want to help us too. God, there are times it is tough to finish what we start. There are times we get tired, or frustrated or we are confused what to do next. You are always with us! Help us to decide it is worth it to finish what we start and give us the strength to keep going. Amen!”

CLOSING:

“Thank you for coming to Alley After Hours at Home Edition tonight everyone! We had a great time. We hope you did too. We can’t wait to see you again soon! Bye!”

Allow kids to say good-bye. Tell them they can now click on “Leave the Meeting”.

Once all kids are gone you can click on “Leave the Meeting” too.
