CRAFT WEEK 3

David and Goliath

SUPPLIES: Goliath page, David cut out, heart sticker, miniature grey pom poms, glue sticks

What You DO and SAY:

⇒ **Pass out Goliath page and David cut out.**

- *“Today in our true Bible story, there was a really big man named Goliath who did not love God. Can you all point to Goliath on your page? Good job!*
- *There was also a boy named David. (Pass out David cut out.) David loved God and believed God would help him be strong and courageous.*
- *Let’s decorate our David and our Goliath.*

⇒ **Pass out a heart sticker to each child.**

- *“Goliath had on lots of heavy armor and a really big sword because he wanted to fight God’s people.*
- *David didn’t have armor or a sword, but he loved God and knew God would help him do big things. So, David said he would battle Goliath! Put this heart sticker on David’s chest to show that he loved God. (Assist the children in sticking the heart on David.)*

⇒ **Pass out glue sticks and 1 pom pom per child.**

- *“David defeated big Goliath with just a sling and a few stones. Let’s glue this pom pom on David’s hand for a stone!*

⇒ **Complete activity and then Bring it Back to Jesus**

- *“These look fantastic! Nice job, friends! Now you can bring the story of David and Goliath home with you! “David knew that God made him to do big things, and as long as David trusted God, he could be strong and courageous. God made you to do big things, too.*
- ***Who made you to do big things?***
- ***God made me to do big things!”***

CRAFT WEEK 4

At the Table Craft

SUPPLIES: At the Table page, Mephibosheth cut out, crayons, glue sticks, food stickers

What You DO and SAY:

- ⇒ **Have children join you at the table. Pass out the At the Table page and the Mephibosheth cut out.**
 - *“Today in our true Bible story we heard about David helping Jonathan’s son, Mephibosheth. “In our Bible story, we heard about some best friends named David and Jonathan. The friends had to say goodbye, but before they did, David promised Jonathan that he would always take care of his family. Later, David became the king, and he remembered his promise. He sent people to find Jonathan’s family. They found Jonathan’s son, Mephibosheth! He couldn’t walk and needed someone to help him. David gave him land, a place to live, people to take care of him, and he always had a place at the table.”*
 - *Can you find King David on your page? Great! Here is Mephibosheth. Let’s color them and then we can glue Mephibosheth in his spot at the table.”*

- ⇒ **Pass out 4 food stickers.**
 - *“King David invited Mephibosheth to the table. Now let’s fill the table with food!”*

- ⇒ **Complete craft and Bring it Back to Jesus**
 - *“David did a very big thing and took care of Mephibosheth. God made us to do very big things and help people, too.*
 - **Who made you to do big things?**
 - **God made me to do big things!”**

CRAFT WEEK 5

Super Kid Mask

SUPPLIES: Superhero mask, crayons, star stickers

What You DO and SAY:

- ⇒ **Have children join you at the table. Pass out Superhero mask**
 - *“Every super kid needs a superhero mask! Let’s make one!”*

- ⇒ **Pass out crayons and 6 star stickers**
 - *“Let’s color our masks and decorate them with stickers so it is as super as you are.*
 - *These look amazing!”*

- ⇒ **If needed, tape the string so it’s secure. Kids can hold mask up to their faces or put on and practice saying the bottom line.**
 - *Great job, Super Kid!*
 - *Now I want you to hold it up to your face and repeat after me – God made me to do big things! Yes he did! Let’s say it again! Who made you to do big things? God made me to do big things!*
 - *He did! And we can praise God just like David did today in our true story!*

- ⇒ **Complete craft and Bring it Back to Jesus**
 - *David knew that God made him to do big things, so he celebrated and praised God. David saved a sheep from a lion when he was a shepherd. David battled the giant, Goliath, when others were too afraid, and he knocked him to the ground. When David became king, he helped take care of Jonathan’s son, Mephibosheth. God made David to do so many big things, and that’s why David praised God by dancing and making music and singing songs. David praised God because he wanted to say thank you. God made us to do big things, so we can celebrate and praise God, too.*
 - ***Who made you to do big things?***
 - ***God made me to do big things!”***

ACTIVITY #1 Week 3

Target Practice

SUPPLIES: Large target picture, bean bags

What You DO and SAY:**

- ⇒ **Gather children near the target. Have them sit down.**
 - *“Today in our true Bible story we learned that God had big things for David to do! He helped him knock down Goliath. Talk about really hitting the target!*
 - *Today we are going to do some target practice, too! Each of you is going to get 2 bean bags and I want you to try to hit the center of the target.*

- ⇒ **Let each child use 2 bean bags. Have them come up one at a time and try to hit the target. Let them try until they make it.**

- ⇒ **Complete the activity and Bring it Back to Jesus.**
 - *“That was a lot of fun! You have great aim just like David! God made David to do big things when he knocked over the giant and he made you to do big things, too!*
 - ***Who made you to do big things?***
 - ***God made me to do big things!”***

****If you have a large class, this would be a great activity to do...**

- ⇒ In stations!
-OR-
- ⇒ With a student helper. Model the activity for the student and hand this paper to them so that they know what to say. During the craft of another activity, have the student helper bring one child at a time over to the target.

ACTIVITY #1 Wk 4

Helping Charades

SUPPLIES: None needed

What You DO and SAY:

- ⇒ **Have children sit down on the rug while you explain the game.**
 - *“Today, we learned that God made us to help others. That’s a BIG thing God made us to do! And there are lots of ways we can help. I will act-out a way to help. I want you to watch what I do and see if you can guess the way I’m helping. Ready? Here we go!”*

- ⇒ **Act out different ways to help.**
 - Some examples of ways to help:
 - Cleaning the floor
 - Setting the table
 - Picking up your toys
 - Wiping the counter
 - Putting away your clothes
 - Sweeping or mopping
 - Washing dishes

- ⇒ **Optional add-on with older kids: Have children volunteer to act out the way to help. Whisper the job in their ear and have them act it out while the other children guess.**

- ⇒ **Optional add-on: Play a bonus round but turn it into a game where EVERYBODY pretends to do the job. You say the job and everyone in the room acts it out.**

- ⇒ **Complete the activity and Bring it Back to Jesus.**
 - *“Wow! There are so many ways we can help. The good news is that God made us to do big things like help others!*
 - ***Who made you to do BIG things?***
 - ***God made me to do BIG things!”***

ACTIVITY #1 Wk 5

Parachute and Praise

SUPPLIES: Parachute, scarves, pom poms, CD player, worship music CD

What You DO and SAY:

⇒ **Have children join you around the parachute.**

- *“Today we learned that King David praised God because God helped him to do big things!*
- *We can praise God, too! Let’s have some fun by putting these fun decorations on the parachute and bouncing them HIGH!”*

⇒ **Turn the music on and have children join you in bouncing the parachute: High, low, fast, slow, etc.**

- *Let’s praise God!!!*

⇒ **Complete the activity and Bring it Back to Jesus.**

- *“Awesome job! God made us all to do big things! We should always praise God!*
- ***Who made you to do BIG things?***
- ***God made me to do BIG things!***

ACTIVITY #2

Hot Potato Super Verse

SUPPLIES: Squishy heart, CD player, worship CD, superhero cape, reward stickers

What You DO and SAY:

- ⇒ **Have children join you in the center of the room and form a circle.**
 - *“Today we are going to play a fun game to help us practice our memory verse. Let’s sit in a circle.*
 - *I have this heart here to remind us of David’s heart. David was strong and courageous because God was with him. We are going to pass the heart around the circle while the music is playing. If you are holding the heart when the music stops, you get to stand up, put the super cape on, and I will help you say the memory verse.*
 - *Are you ready?*

- ⇒ **Play music and have kids pass the heart around. Pause the music. Have the child holding the heart stand up and put the super cape on. Have them say the memory verse, with or without help. Give them a sticker when they are done.**
 - *“Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid...for the Lord your God goes with you.’ Deuteronomy 31:6”*

- ⇒ **Continue until all children have had a turn to wear the cape and say the verse.**

- ⇒ **Repeat as long as children are interested and then Bring it Back to Jesus.**
 - *“Great work, superkids! We can all be strong and courageous because God goes with us and he made us to do big things!*
 - ***Who made you to do big things? God made me to do big things!”***

ACTIVITY #3

Super Kid Freeze

SUPPLIES: CD Player, worship music CD

What You DO and SAY:

- ⇒ **Have children join you in the center of the room and space out.**
 - *“Super Kids are going to dance! I am going to turn on a song and when you hear the music I want you to DANCE! When the music stops, everyone FREEZE in a super-kid pose. Let’s practice a few super hero poses.....*
 - *Great job! Are you ready to play? Let’s go!*

- ⇒ **Play music and let kids dance. Pause music and have them freeze.**
 - *“FREEZE in your Super Kid pose! Nice!*
 - ***Who made you to do big things?***
 - ***God made me to do big things!***
 - *Let’s dance!*

- ⇒ **Repeat as long as children are interested.**

- ⇒ **Complete the activity and then Bring it Back to Jesus.**
 - *“Great dancing, everyone! You are such super kids!*
 - *Who made you to do big things?*
 - ***God made me to do big things!”***

SANITIZE HANDS AND PASS OUT MOON SAND

READ

- ⇒ The Bible
 - *Beginner's Bible: David and Goliath, p. 173*

REVIEW *(You may choose to pass out stickers as kids answer!)*

- ⇒ Key Question and Bottom Line
 - **Who made you to do big things?**
God made me to do big things!
- ⇒ Memory Verse
 - **“Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid...for the Lord your God goes with you.” Deuteronomy 31:6**

CONNECT IT AND PRAY

CONNECT IT QUESTION: What is one big thing God made you to do?

- ⇒ “David was able to do the big things God made him to do because he loved God and trusted God would go with him. Today we will make a list of big things WE can do when we’re strong and courageous because we know God is with us. So let’s think of big things we can do when we are strong and courageous. When I say your name, **tell me one big thing God made you to do**, and I will write it down.
 - *Write the names down on the weekly question strip/board/paper.*
- ⇒ You really are SUPER kids! God has big things in store for you to do. Let’s pray!
- ⇒ Let’s fold our hands and bow our heads and **pray**:
 - *“Dear God, Thank You for making (name each child). Help us to trust that You are always with us so we can be strong and courageous enough to do the big things You made us to do. Big things like (read list children made). You are amazing, God, and we love You. In Jesus’ name, amen.”*

SANITIZE HANDS AND PASS OUT MOON SAND

READ

⇒ The Bible

- *Beginner's Bible: Best Friends, p. 181*

REVIEW *(You may choose to pass out stickers as kids answer!)*

⇒ Key Question and Bottom Line

- **Who made you to do big things?**
God made me to do big things!

⇒ Memory Verse

- **“Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid...for the Lord your God goes with you.” Deuteronomy 31:6**

CONNECT IT AND PRAY

CONNECT IT QUESTION: Who is one person you can help?

⇒ “David helped Mephibosheth in our story today. There are lots of people we can help, too. That’s why we’re going to make a list of people we can help. I want you to think about the people in your house, your neighborhood, your school, and here at church. When I say your name, **tell me one person you can help**, and I will write it down.

- *Have each child share and write the ideas down on the weekly question strip/board/paper.*

⇒ This is a great list of people! Let’s pray and thank God for making us to do big things and help these people.

⇒ Let’s fold our hands and bow our heads and **pray**:

- *“Dear God, thank You for making (name each child) to help others. Helping others is a big thing! Please help all of us be strong and courageous so [child’s name] can help [person they listed] and [child’s name] can help [person they listed] and . . . (continue with each child). We love You, God. In Jesus’ name, amen.”*

SANITIZE HANDS AND PASS OUT MOON SAND

READ

- ⇒ The Bible
 - *Beginner's Bible: King David, p. 186*

REVIEW *(You may choose to pass out stickers as kids answer!)*

- ⇒ Key Question and Bottom Line
 - **Who made you to do big things?**
God made me to do big things!
- ⇒ Memory Verse
 - **“Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid...for the Lord your God goes with you.” Deuteronomy 31:6**

CONNECT IT AND PRAY

CONNECT IT QUESTION: What is one way you can praise God?

- ⇒ “Today we learned that David praised God! David was so grateful for all of the big things God helped him to do in his life that he wanted to say THANK YOU to God. We can praise and thank God, too! Some of the ways we can praise God are by dancing, singing, helping others, and praying. When I say your name, **tell me one way you can praise God**, and I will write it down.
 - *Write the names down on the weekly question strip/board/paper.*
- ⇒ These are all great ways! We can praise God by praying, too. Let's pray and thank him now.
- ⇒ Let's fold our hands and bow our heads and **pray**:
 - *“Dear God, You are amazing! You made the whole world and everything in it, and that means You made (name each child). And not only did You make each of them, but You made them to be super kids and do big things! I pray they will always look to You to know what to do. We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen.”*
